New Culture

Bring together international and domestic thinkers, philosophers, scientists, and actors in cutting-edge fields, organizing cross-border dialogues to jointly explore new possibilities for civilization transformation. The new platform is "Beyond Climate Dialogue," which have invited Emma Sky, founding director of the Yale International Leadership Center, and Mary Evelyn Tucker, a leading scholar in global ecology and religion from Yale University.

New Agenda

Promote exchange and cooperation between China and the world through joint experiments, pilot projects, and international exchanges. The ongoing social experiments include the Global Accelerator of Food System Transformation (GAFST) jointly developed by Harvard and PKU, the synergy between climate and biodiversity, climate and gender, and Carbon Neutrality and Rural Revitalization, etc.

New Actors

Youth are the masters of the carbon neutral future. C Force have developed a series of 3C Leadership workshops and platforms for global youth to stimulate curiosity, courage, and compassion. The pilots include PKU-Sciences Po Climate Week, Climate Future Youth Workshops, etc.

New Narrative

Faced with many challenges and uncertainties in the future, the brain's first reaction is fight or escape. Combining the exploration findings of new culture, new agenda, and new actors, C Force is developing positive and optimistic narratives and providing a continuous internal support for co-creating the future.

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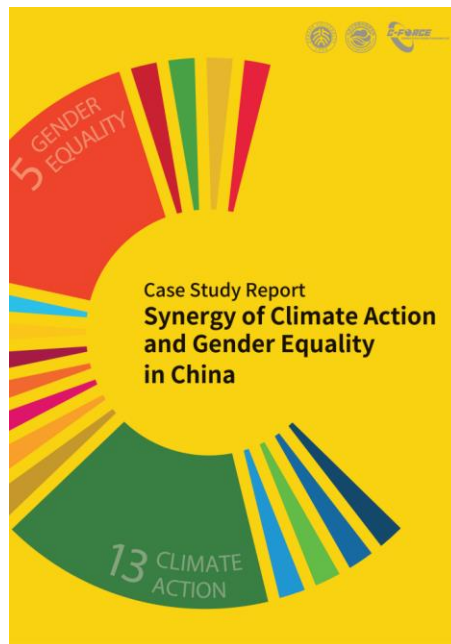

Countries such as Georgia, **Kazakhstan**, Mongolia, Pakistan, Tajikistan, and Uzbekistan demonstrate more robust integration

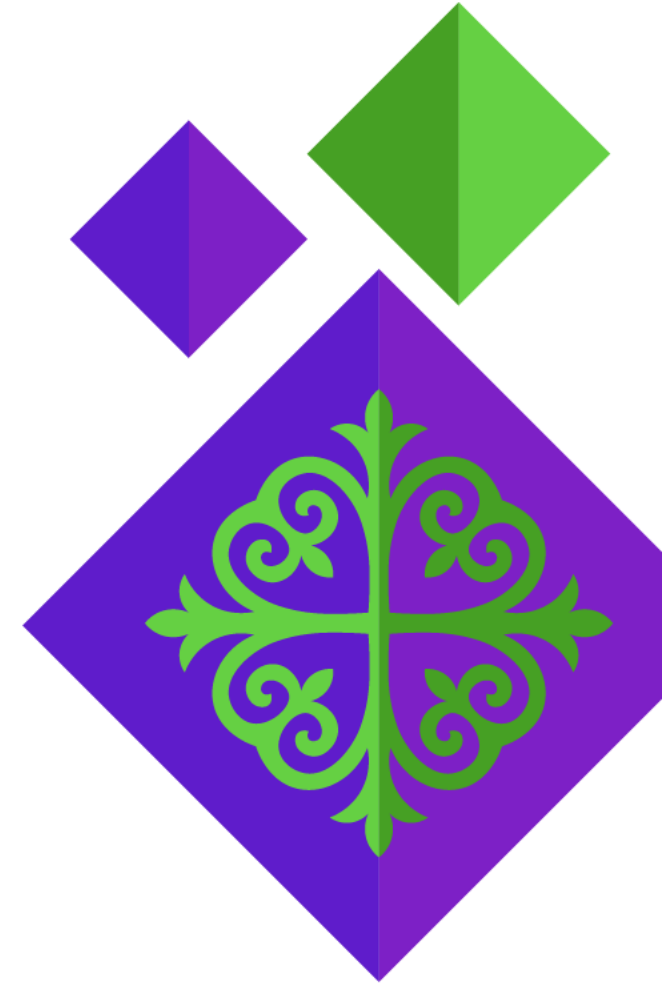
Emerging Alignment

Needs to be improved

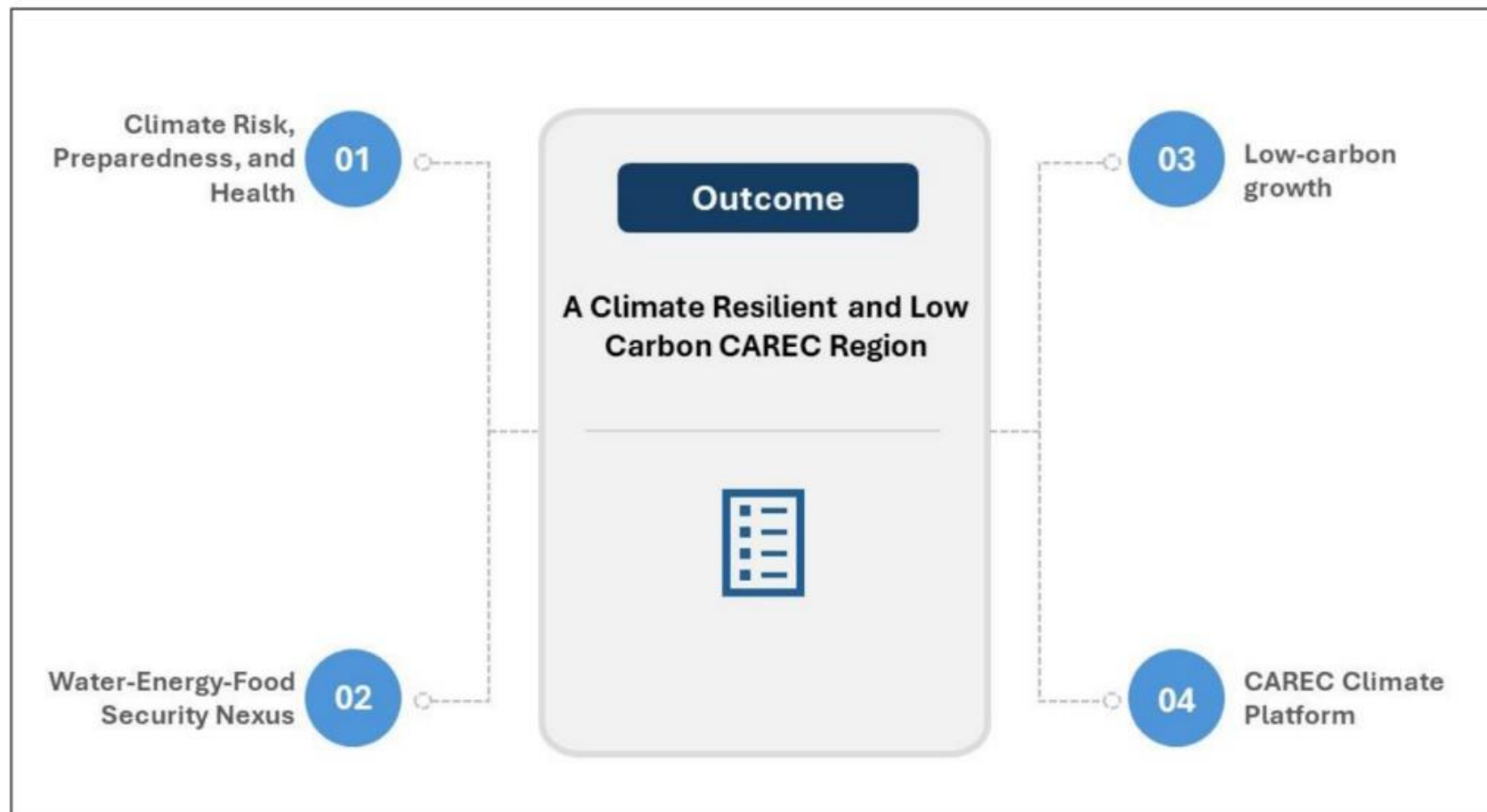

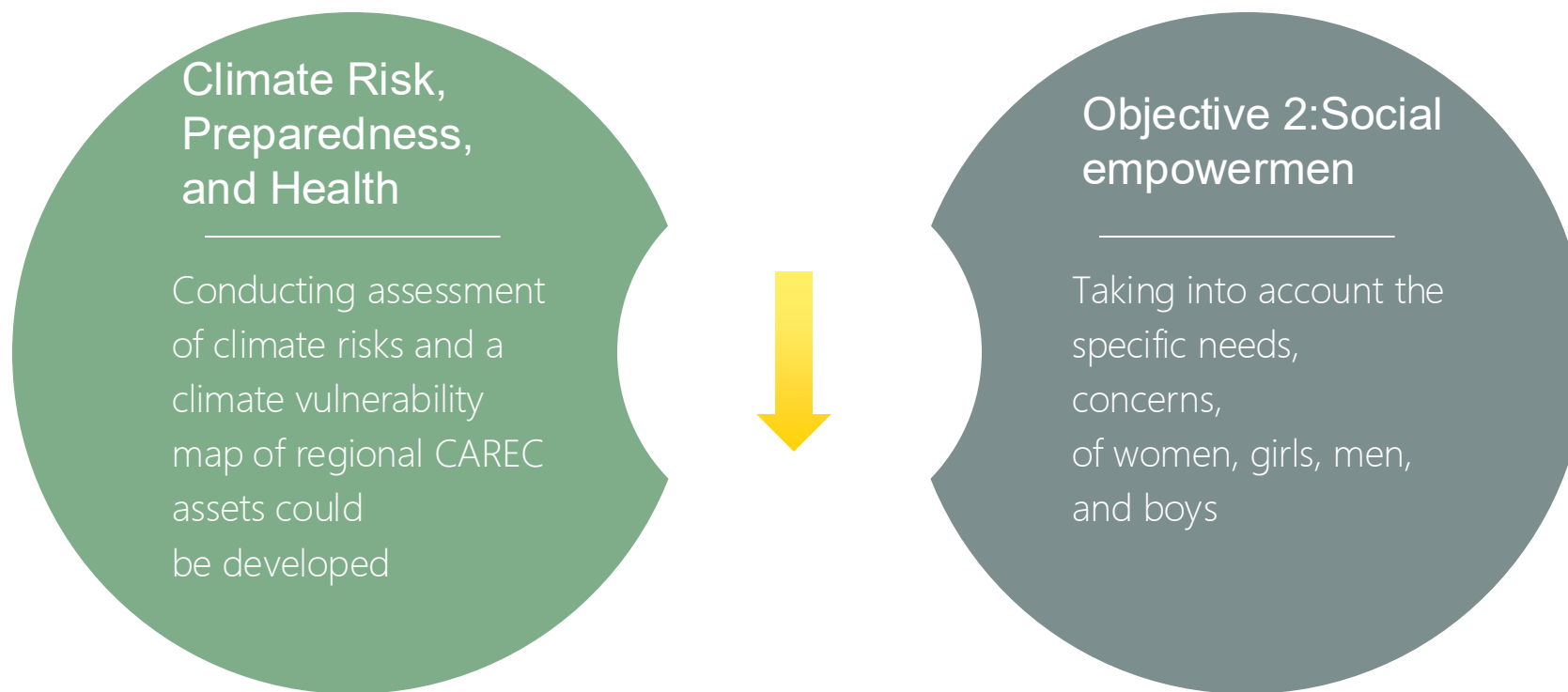
